Guest Speaker

Rodney Lee Little II

The Latrobe Business & Professional Women's (BPW) Club is excited to announce its guest speaker for the January meeting: Rodney Lee Little II, President of the Top Dog Therapy Team, CEO of Youngwood Top Dog and Editor in Chief of The Top Dog Canine Chronicles Rodney will share his inspiring journey, from his childhood love for animals to his triumph over life-threatening adversity, and how these experiences shaped his work with therapy dogs.

Rodney's lifelong passion for animals began in his small farm town in Westmoreland County, where he developed a deep connection with animals at a young age leading to clear calling working with animals. After joining the Army in 1999 and serving overseas, Rodney was introduced to German-style dog training, a skill he quickly adopted and carried back to the United States. His work with dogs expanded when he joined New Jersey K-9 Search and Rescue and the New Jersey Rescue and Recovery Unit. In 2007, Rodney returned to Pennsylvania, where he worked alongside police and law enforcement agencies on missing person cases and animal response teams until 2013. It was in 2014 that he launched Youngwood Top Dog Therapy Services, providing specialized dog training and community-based therapy dog programs.

However, Rodney's life changed dramatically on July 9, 2016. While leaving church on his Harley Davidson, Rodney was struck by a car, resulting in severe injuries. After a life-threatening crash and multiple surgeries, Rodney spent over a year in recovery, initially paralyzed from the waist down. He credits his recovery to his faith and determination, stating, "I stopped asking God to change my circumstances, and I asked God to use my circumstances to change me, and He did."

During his long recovery, Rodney's dog Sarge became his unwavering companion, providing him with emotional support and healing. Sarge, a retired working canine, now works alongside Rodney in the mission of Top Dog Therapy Services, which visits over 400 local facilities each year, bringing comfort and love to those who need it most.

In addition to his work with therapy dogs, Rodney's faith led him to pursue ministry. He was certified in 2021 and has since preached in various settings, including nursing homes and retirement centers. Together with his wife, Lara Custer, and their son Walker, Rodney continues to serve his community and the Lord.

About Youngwood Top Dog Therapy Services:

Founded by Rodney Little, Youngwood Top Dog Therapy Services provides specialized dog training and therapy dog programs. Their mission is to bring comfort and joy to those in need by utilizing the incredible bond between humans and dogs. Top Dog Therapy currently works with over 130 therapy dogs and serves over 400 facilities in the local community each year.




