Dear Members



Renee Reitz Blackburn Center

Latrobe Business and Professional Women's Club Tuesday announced its March meeting will feature Renee Reitz, executive director of the Blackburn Center, as the guest speaker.

Reitz has dedicated her career to supporting survivors of domestic and sexual violence through her work with the Blackburn Center, a nonprofit organization in Greensburg. Blackburn Center's mission is to advocate for the rights of individuals to live free from violence, eliminating its root causes and ensuring the safety and well-being of victims and survivors.

Renee's journey with the organization began in 2015, and since then, she has risen through the ranks, holding various leadership roles, including shelter counselor, assistant advocacy program manager, advocacy program manager, and program director before being appointed executive director in 2022.

Under Renee's leadership, the Blackburn Center has continued its critical work, providing crisis counseling, legal and medical advocacy, professional training, and support to individuals and families impacted by violence. Her passion for the mission and strategic insight have made her an invaluable resource to the community she serves.


Walk a Mile in her Shoes






